Janice welcomed everyone to the meeting and began with a description of the virtual annual general meeting. The voting process was communicated to the group.

Acknowledgements were made by the Chair of Mi'kmaq territory, communities of African descent and the 71st anniversary of the John Howard Society of Nova Scotia.

Call to Order: Janice Fiander called the meeting to order at 5:38 pm and a quorum was declared.

Approval of Agenda: Moved by Carolyn O'Malley, seconded by Fred Honsberger, that the agenda for the AGM be approved. Carried.

Confirmation of minutes of 2019-20 AGM: Motion by Kit Waters, seconded by Carolyn O'Malley, that the minutes of the 2019-20 Annual General Meeting be confirmed. Carried.

Review of 2020-21 Annual Reports: The full reports are contained within the annual report – the highlights from each are as follows:

President of the Board: Janice Fiander acknowledged the Society's seventy-one years of service milestone by highlighting the Society's long-standing history as a non-profit organization. She highlighted how JHSNS remained responsive during the pandemic; and accomplished lots of great work. She recognized that the Province is starting to open up and said she is hopeful the John Howard Society of Canada's annual General meeting will be able to be

held safely in Halifax in October 2021. She then shared her appreciation for the Society's staff and volunteers for their work, especially for their ongoing efforts in supporting clients during the COVID-19 pandemic. Janice finished by thanking the Society's partners, Board Members and the interim Executive Director.

Executive Director: Sean Kelly acknowledged the Society's seventy-one years of service. Sean shared the highlights and successes of the 3 regional offices. Which can be found in more detail in the Annual Report. He concluded with special thanks to community partners, staff, and the Board of Directors.

Financial Statements: The audited statement for fiscal year 2020-21 was presented by Carolyn O'Malley, who noted that the Society has a healthy income statement this year. Carolyn had previously distributed the Auditors Report to the Board and she advised that it was a clean audit. Motion by Carolyn O'Malley and seconded by Janis Aitken that the Auditor's report be accepted. Carried.

Appointment of External Auditors: Moved by Carolyn O'Malley, seconded by Fred Honsberger, that Miles T. Sweeney Ltd. be appointed as external auditors for the JHSNS for the fiscal year 2021-2022. **Carried.**

Nominating Report: Kit Waters presented the report of the Nominating Committee, recommending that the following individuals be re-appointed to a two-year term to the JHSNS Board: Janis Aitken, Janice Fiander, Louise Grey and Julie Slen. The Committee further recommended that the following new Board members be appointed for a two-year term: Jane MacMaster, Bev Walker, Alexander McKillop and Alicia Brown-Fagen.

A call for 'further nominations' from the floor was made three times. There being none, it was moved by Kit Waters, seconded by Carolyn O'Malley, that the Nomination Report be accepted as presented and that the directors who have agreed to stand for a two-year term be acclaimed. **Carried**.

Ratification of Acts of Directors: Motion by Janice Fiander, seconded by Kit Waters that all resolutions, contracts, acts and proceedings of the Board of Directors of the Society since the last Annual General Meeting of members be approved. **Carried.**

Janice Fiander thanked everyone for attending the virtual meeting and expressed hope for an in person meeting for the John Howard Society of Canada's AGM in Halifax in October 2021
